Communal Processing Unitary Enterprise "Brestvodokanal", hereinafter referred to as "the Employer", has received:

- a loan from the Nordic Investment Bank (NIB) 10 MEUR;
- a non-refundable technical aid from the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) 41 MSEK;

towards the cost of the Works Contract A1-1 under the Project "Reconstruction of Brest Wastewater Treatment Plant".

Communal Processing Unitary Enterprise "Brestvodokanal" now invites sealed tenders from eligible tenderers for the following contract.

Contract A1-1. Reconstruction of Brest WWTP, average flow 80 400 m3/d, including stage A and stage C design and obtaining official approvals of design for the reconstruction and rehabilitation works, including supply of related equipment (except equipment supplied under Contract A1-2), spare parts, all installation works and related services.

In addition, contractor for contract A1-1 shall check and approve the design, and install the equipment supplied under supply contract A1-2 (2 million EURO non-refundable technical aid from the Northern Dimension Environmental Partnership (NDEP)).

Planned Contract completion period is 29 months. The contractor shall complete stage A and stage C designs for the contract and obtain State Expertise approval for the designs within 8 months from the commencement of the contract.

Contract A1-1 Eligibility and Qualification Criteria

Firms from all countries are eligible to be awarded this Contract A1-1.

To be qualified for the award of the Contract A1-1, tenderers must satisfy the minimum criteria in Tender Documents, including but not limited to:

- the Tenderer is not bankrupt or under bankruptcy procedures according to the national legislation or regulations;
- the Tenderer shall have an average annual turnover as prime contractor (defined as billing for works in progress or completed) over the last three years of not less than 12 million EUR equivalent;
- experience of participation as contractor, management contractor or supplier in at least three (3) contracts within the last five (5) years, each with a value of at least

EUR 3 million, successfully and substantially completed and similar to the proposed Works:

- the Tenderer shall demonstrate in addition, the following specific experience: Participation in successful reconstruction of Biological Wastewater Treatment Plant in similar weather conditions under operation having capacity not less than 50 000 m3/day and have experience of in-situ casting of monolith water-tight concrete;
- the Tenderer or its nominated subcontractor/subconsultant shall have experience of stage A and C design of biological wastewater treatment plant in Belarus;
- the Tenderer shall provide evidence that the Tenderer or its agent will be able to carry out the Contractor's maintenance, repair and spare parts stocking obligations;
- for Belarusian Tenderers: the Tenderer shall provide evidence that the Tenderer and its sub-contractor(s) shall have or shall obtain prior to the Contract award all certificates, permits and licences required by the authorities of the Republic of Belarus related to the scope of this contract (such as design and construction permits issued by Belarusian Self-Regulatory Organisations in appropriate sectors or by other authorised organisations);
- the Tenderer shall be certified for quality standard ISO 9001 (or equivalent) or shall submit his own quality assurance plan to demonstrate quality assurance procedures, which shall be applied for the execution of works under this contract.
